



Chaperone Guide

Thank you for taking the time to serve as a chaperone for your school. You play a vital role in your students' experiences at the Golisano Children's Museum of Naples (C'mon). Make sure you ask your students questions about what they are seeing and learning about – it will enhance their experience.

As a chaperone, you should:

- Stay with your group and keep your group together at all times
- Model how to be respectful of Museum exhibits, staff and other guests
- Participate with students' play and learning
- Focus all of your attention on your assigned students instead of other adults in the group

Student Behavior Expectations:

- Students should use their "inside voices," meaning no loud talking or shouting.
- Students are expected to walk, not run.
- Students must stay in their groups with their chaperones at all times.
- Students should leave all bags, cell phones, iPods, and game devices on the bus or at school. There is no space to store these items and the Museum will not be responsible for any items left or stolen.
- Students should only eat or drink in designated areas. No food or drink is permitted in the exhibits.
- Students are not permitted to touch artwork in the Loos Art Gallery. The oils in skin can damage one-of-a-kind artwork and artifacts.
